Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014

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Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014*.

2 Purpose and how it is to be achieved

- (1) The purpose of this subordinate local law is to supplement *Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014* in order to protect the health and safety of persons using local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads and preserve features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.
- (2) The purpose is to be achieved by providing for—
 - (a) the regulation of access to local government controlled areas; and
 - (b) the prohibition or restriction of particular activities in local government controlled areas or roads.

3 Authorising local law

The making of the provisions in this subordinate local law is authorised by *Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014* (the *authorising local law*).

4 Definitions

Particular words used in this subordinate local law have the same meaning as provided for in the authorising local law.

Part 2 Use of local government controlled areas, facilities and roads

5 Prohibited and restricted activities—Authorising local law, s 5(1)

- (1) For section 5(1)(a) of the authorising local law, the activities prescribed in column 2 of schedule 1 are declared to be prohibited in the corresponding local government controlled area or road (or part thereof) mentioned in column 1 of schedule 1.
- (2) For section 5(1)(b) of the authorising local law, the activities prescribed in column 2 of schedule 2 are declared to be restricted in the corresponding local government controlled area or road (or part thereof) mentioned in column 1 of schedule 2, to the extent described in column 3 of schedule 2.

Schedule 1 Prohibited activities for local government controlled areas or roads

1	All local government cemeteries in the area	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Interfering with a funeral or commemorative service lawfully conducted in a local government cemetery. 2 Interfering with a grave or memorial, except maintenance or repair by family members that has been authorised by the chief executive officer.
2	All parks and reserves in the local government area	Damaging or interfering with— <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) any fauna, plants or plant material, soils, sands or rocks; or (b) facilities, notices or equipment.


Schedule 2 Restricted activities for local government controlled areas or roads

Section 5(2)

Column 1 Local government controlled area or road	Column 2 Restricted activity	Column 3 Extent of restriction
1 All local government controlled areas and roads	Camping	<p>Permitted only in one or more of the following circumstances—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) in a caravan park operated under an approval granted by the local government under <i>Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014</i>; (b) in a camping reserve designated by the local government; (c) more than 200m by road from a designated town area; (d) while driving stock pursuant to a permit for the driving of the stock; (e) while stopped in roadside rest areas designated by the local government or the department administering State-controlled roads; (f) where specifically authorised by an approval for a prescribed activity granted by the local government under <i>Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014</i>; (g) where specifically authorised by the chief executive officer for defence force or emergency services personnel engaged in training or similar activities; (h) where specifically authorised by the chief executive officer for participants of fundraising or other specific activities such as the Boulia Camel Races.
