(MAKING OF LOCAL LAWS AND SUBORDINATE LOCAL LAWS) NOTICE (NO.1) 2014

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Boulia Shire Council (Making of Local Laws and Subordinate Local Laws) Notice (No.1) 2014*.

Making of amendment local law and amendment subordinate local law

2. Pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act 2009*, the Boulia Shire Council made the following laws by resolution on 18th December 2014:
 - a. *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014*;
 - b. *Model Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011*. The local law so adopted will be referred to as *Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2014* of the Council's Local Laws;
 - c. *Model Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2011*. The local law so adopted will be referred to as *Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2014* of the Council's Local Laws;
 - d. *Model Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011*. The local law so adopted will be referred to as *Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014* of the Council's Local Laws;
 - e. *Subordinate Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014*;
 - f. *Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2014*;
 - g. *Subordinate Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014*."

Local laws repealed

3. *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014* repeals the following local laws: *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 1999*; *Local Law No.2 (Protection of Vegetation) 1999*; *Local Law No.3 (Gates and Grids) 1999*; *Local Law No.4 (Libraries) 1999*; *Local Law No.5 (Meetings) 1999*; *Local Law No.6 (Keeping and Control of Animals) 1999*; *Local Law No.7 (Cemeteries) 1999*; *Local Law No.8 (Extractive Industries) 1999*; *Local Law No.9 (Entertainment Venues) 1999*; *Local Law No.10 (Temporary Homes) 1999*; *Local Law No.11 (Control of Signs) 1999*; *Local Law No.12 (Rental Accommodation) 1999*; *Local Law No.13 (Control of Pests) 1999*; *Local Law No.14 (Saleyards) 1999*; *Local Law No.15 (Domestic Water Carriers) 1999*; *Local Law No.16 (Blasting Operations) 1999*; *Local Law No.17 (Parks and Reserves) 1999*; *Local Law No.18 (Control of Nuisances) 1999*; *Local Law No.19 (Commercial Use of Roads) 1999*; *Local Law No.20 (Roads) 1999*; *Local Law No.21 (Aerodromes) 1999*; *Local Law No.22 (Caravan Park Operators) 1999*; *Local Law No.23 (Camping and Camping Grounds) 1999*; *Local Law No.24 (Swimming Pools) 1999*; *Local Law No.25 (Local Government Swimming Pools) 1999*; *Local Law No.26 (Control of Local Government Premises) 1999*.

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Model Local Laws incorporated

4. The following local laws incorporate Model Local Laws:
 - a. *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014;*
 - b. *Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2014;*
 - c. *Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2014;*
 - d. *Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014.*

Local law that authorises the subordinate local laws to be made

5. *Subordinate Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014* is authorised to be made by *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014.*
6. *Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2014* is authorised to be made by *Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2014.*
7. *Subordinate Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014* is authorised to be made by *Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014.*

Purpose and general effect of the local laws and subordinate local laws

8. The purposes and general effect of the new local laws is to provide for:
 - (a) a legal and procedural framework for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the local government's local laws, subordinate local laws and other regulatory powers, and for miscellaneous administrative matters (*Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014* and *Subordinate Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2014*);
 - (b) the management of animals by minimising the risk to community health, safety and amenity, reducing environmental harm or environmental nuisance, and supporting animal owners to keep their animals in a manner that is consistent with the expectations of the community (*Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2014* and *Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2014*);
 - (c) protection of community health, safety and amenity and the environmental values of the region within the local government's area by providing for the elimination or reduction of risks and threats to the environment and community health, safety and amenity resulting from:
 - inadequate protection against animal or plant pests; and
 - vegetation overgrowth; and
 - visual pollution resulting from accumulation of objects and materials; and
 - fires and fire hazards not regulated by State law; and
 - community safety hazards; and
 - noise that exceeds noise standards(*Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2014*)
 - (d) protection of the health and safety of persons using local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads; regulation of the use of local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads to prevent property damage or a loss of amenity or a nuisance; and preservation of features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads (*Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014* and *Subordinate Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014*).

Anti-competitive provisions


9. The following laws contain anti-competitive provisions:
