Recruitment of Wellness Connector Healthy Outback Communities Initiative

The Western Queensland Primary Health Network (WQPHN) is introducing a new approach to the health and well-being of remote channel country communities such as Boulia.

Known as Healthy Outback Communities (HOC), it has a focus on staying well rather than only treating illnesses. It will make access to services easier, to prevent long-term health issues and encourage healthy lifestyles.

A key part of the approach will be the employment of a person in the role of Wellbeing Connector as the link between residents and the services and activities that will assist in achieving improved outcomes.

The Wellness Connector is to focus on understanding community needs and identifying services, resources and activities that will support our community in the long-term.

Recruitment by WQPHN for the part-time Wellness
Connector is being extended and would ideally be filled by a
local person in Boulia. Applications from Aboriginal and
Torres Strait Islander candidates are strongly encouraged.
